Recently, we have launched e-PPF through Internet Banking System. The details of the Scheme is as under for uploading the same at PNB Website :-

Facility of PPF Account Opening using Internet Banking System (IBS) ID and Password by customers has been started in PNB. Customer can avail this facility round the clock by Log-in to Internet Banking System using his ID and Password following the simple steps mentioned hereunder :

(A) For IBS Users using their IBS ID & Password

<u>Step I</u>

- (i) Log-in to **IBS** using **ID** and **Password**.
- (ii) Go to option "My short-cut" <> "PPF Account" <> "Open a PPF Account".
- (iii) Inet PPF Account opening shall populate on screen.

<u>Step II</u>

- (i) From Drop Down Menu, please choose Self A/c or Minor A/c.
- (ii) Fill up all the **PPF Account Opening details** available on screen and select a name of authorized branch from drop down menu where the PPF Account shall be opened and maintained.
- (iii) Enter **Submit**.

<u>Step III</u>

- (i) After "Submit", Request Confirmation screen shall appear.
- (ii) Enter Transaction Password and "Submit".

Step IV

(i) After entering Submit, "**Cyber Receip**t" with **GBM Reference number** shall be generated on IBS screen. Information submitted by IBS user for opening PPF Account shall be available for 7 days only.

<u>Step V</u>

- (i) Press OK button to download **PDF file** and take **print-out of Account Opening Form** (AOF) having GBM Reference on it.
- (ii) Paste the **Photo** on Account Opening Form and enclose the copy **KYC documents** e.g., Copy of PAN No, Copy of Ration Card, Copy of Voter ID etc.
- (iii) Hand-over the Account Opening Form along with KYC documents to the authorised PPF branch selected by him from drop down menu where the PPF Account shall be opened.

(B) For GBM-PPF Users at PPF Authorised Branch

<u>Step I</u>

(i) Branch User to Log-in to GBM <> PPF.

<u>Step II</u>

(i) Select sub-option "Inet Account Opening" i.e. last option available under main option "Masters".

<u>Step III</u>

(i) Click on **"Add"** button and select the **"GBM reference No**." available on Account Opening Form, by **using TORCH** icon and **Submit**.

Step IV

(i) After submit, **Account Opening** screen with GBM Reference No. will appear with details of PPF Account Holder. The fields can be edited before verification.

Step V

(i) Check PPF Account Opening details ensuring that all the details are filled in GBM-PPF procedurally and Submit.

<u>Step VI</u>

(i) After **Submit**, **PPF Account Number** will be generated.

Step VI : Verification Process

- (i) After generation of PPF Account Number, branch with different user ID in GBM-PPF has to verify the record of PPF Account Number by selecting GBM <> PPF <> Inet Account opening <> Verify.
- (ii) Select the **GBM Reference No.** by click on **Torch Icon** available on GBM-PPF screen and press **Submit** button ensuring that all details of PPF Account opening are correctly feeded in GBM-PPF.
- (iii) **PPF Account successfully verified** will appear on GBM-PPF screen.
- (iv) Make transaction in the PPF Account with the amount tendered by customer.
- (v) PPF Account No. shall be linked immediately with IBS ID & Password of customer for making transactions in the account on-line.

2. Facility of depositing subscription in PPF Account on-line, using IBS ID/Password by the customer has been provided and made live. Customer can avail this facility from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. by log-in to IBS using his ID and password. Simple steps for depositing PPF subscription on-line are given hereunder :-

- (i) Log-in to IBS using ID/password.
- (ii) Go to option "Accounts" <> PPF Accounts
- (iii) Select PPF Account Number from authorised SOLs.
- (iv) After selecting PPF Account number, click on "Make Payment" icon.
- (v) Enter subscription amount to be deposited and click 'continue' icon.
- (vi) Enter transaction password to confirm the payment and click on 'submit' icon.
- (vii) On clicking 'submit' icon, amount entered by user will be credited to his/her PPF account. In case, there is error, the system shall display the same on screen.
