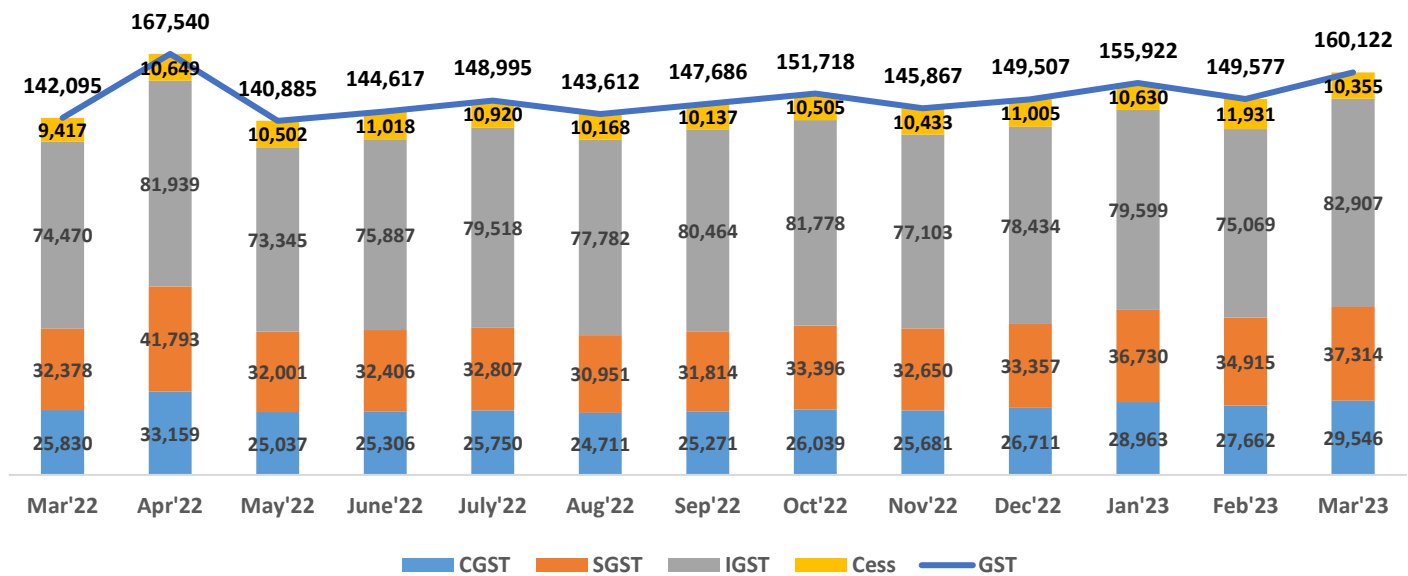

Highlights:

GST collections grew by 13% over corresponding period last year

- Rs.1,60,122 crore gross GST revenue collected in the month of March 2023.
- This is the second highest collection in the Financial Year 2023.
- The GST has been showing an average collection of more than 1.50 lakh crore.
