<u>Central Scheme to provide Interest Subsidy (CSIS) on Education Loans to EWS</u> students

Brief of the Scheme:

In pursuit of providing professional education to the students belonging to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS); Government of India, Ministry of Human Resources Development, and Department of Higher Education has approved "Central Scheme to provide Interest Subsidy- (CSIS)".

The scheme provides full interest subsidy during the period of moratorium on education loans taken by EWS students for pursuing any of the approved courses of studies in technical / professional streams from recognized institutions in India.

As per communication received from IBA vide their Letter No. RB/CIR/ELCSIS/5094 dated 11.05.2018, Ministry of Human Resource Development, GoI have issued revised guidelines of Central Sector Interest Subsidy Scheme (CSIS), which are applicable for the academic year 2018-19 and 2019-20, commencing from 01.04.2018 as under:

i.	Objective of the Scheme	This scheme benefits all categories of economically weaker students for pursuing Professional/ technical courses in India only. CSIS aims to check the existing geographical imbalance with regard to Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher Education Institutions.
ii.	Applicability/ Features of the scheme	The Scheme is adopted by all Scheduled Banks and is linked with the existing Model Educational Loan scheme of the Indian Banks' Association, and restricted to students enrolled in professional/ technical courses only from NAAC accredited institutions or professional/ technical programmes accredited by NBA or institutions of National importance or Central Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs). Those Professional institutions/ programmes, which do not come under the ambit of NAAC or NBA, would require approval of the respective regulatory body viz, approval of Medical Council of India for Medical courses, Nursing courses, Bar Council of India for Law etc.
iii.	Income /Limit Proof	The benefits of the Scheme are applicable to students belonging to economically weaker sections, with

Monitoring	An Interest Subsidy & Credit Guarantee dashboard would be set up by the Nodal Bank for the Scheme with real-time data from banks on geographical/ socioeconomic/gender/ institutional accreditation grade of the institution/ category/ course wise distribution of loan applications, sanctions, subsidy released and adjusted, loan repayments, NPAs, etc. This dashboard will ensure effective monitoring and enable the Ministry to measure the outcome of the Scheme.

As per IBA letter No.RB/CIR/EDL/5439 dated 05.07.2018, MoHRD, GOI has decided to implement **Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)** process, so that the subsidy released by the Ministry can be credited directly to the individual loan accounts by Nodal Bank (Canara Bank).

It is also decided by the MoHRD (GOI) to settle the subsidy only to those accounts whose moratorium period has ended or ending shortly.

The following details have now been made mandatory for credit of CSIS Subsidy in individual eligible accounts by Nodal Bank:

- Saving Bank Account Number
- Name of Beneficiary
- IFSC Code
- Gender
- Category (Gen, SC, ST, OBC, etc.)
- Moratorium Ending Date.

As per IBA Notification No. RB/CIR/CSIS/7688 dated 02.08.2019, following details/ fields have been made mandatory in updated Data Structure Document (DSD) dated 01.08.2019 for submission of claims for the FY-2018-19:

- Accredited Institution: In case record in this field is No (N) and loan sanction date
 is on or after 01.04.2018, records will be rejected by the system with error
 "unaccredited institute".
- Third Party Guarantee or Collateral Security: In case record in this field is YES
 (Y) and loan sanction date is on or after 01.04.2018, records will be rejected by
 the system with error "Ineligible due to third party guarantee or collateral
 security".
- Saving Account Number: as per CBS system.

IBA vide their letter No. RB/CSIS/7913 dated 21.09.2019 has informed that following the various representations from member banks, MoHRD has permitted to make Aadhaar as optional.

Moratorium Period: Course Period plus one year.

<u>Income Limit / Proof</u>: The benefit is applicable to the student belonging to economically weaker sections (EWS), having parental income **upper limit of Rs. 4.5 lakh per year (from all sources).** The designated authorities to give Income proof under this scheme have been authorized by the respective State Governments.

Nodal Bank: Canara Bank is the Nodal Bank for implementation and monitoring of the scheme.

<u>Miscellaneous</u>: On completion of moratorium period, the interest on the outstanding loan amount shall be paid by the student, in accordance with the provisions of the educational loan Scheme.

For Education loans exceeding Rs.10 lakh the subsidy under the scheme is available up to Rs.10 lakh only for studies in India upto 31.03.2018.

Further, subsidy amount will be only for Rs.7.50 lakh irrespective of sanctioned loan amount (within the parameters of IBA Model Education Loan Scheme) for all loans taken w.e.f. 01.04.2018.
