PNB will now allow customers to register on its application PNB ONE by using their Aadhaar credentials and OTP-based authentication

Punjab National Bank (PNB) will now allow customers to register on its application PNB ONE by using their Aadhaar credentials and OTP-based authentication.

In Aadhaar-OTP authentication, a one-time PIN is sent to the registered mobile number of the Aadhaar card holder. Do remember the OTP is valid

for a limited period, according to the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website. For Aadhaar-OTP authentication, the Aadhaar card holder needs to provide his or her Aadhaar card number and OTP sent to their mobile number. Your mobile number must be linked with your Aadhaar card to do Aadhaar-OTP authentication.

PNB is the first bank to introduce onboarding on its flagship application through Aadhaar-OTP authentication, said the bank in a press release.
